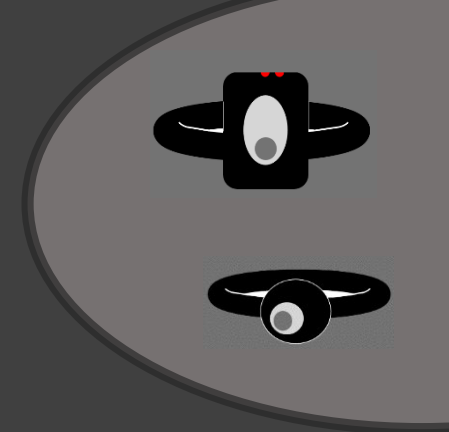


# HOW DOES *the* ELECTRONIC MONITORING OF CHILDREN

## *work in the Netherlands?*



### Court

In most cases, courts decide whether a child should be on EM. If a child is spending a prison sentence, court decision is not needed to impose EM for the purpose of rehabilitation or leave.



### Advice

Probation workers advise **whether an RF or a GPS device** should be used for monitoring the Court's conditions.



### Probation

Probation workers arrange the fitting of the tag and ensure that monitoring schedules are set up in the system.

### Monitoring

The Probation Service monitors compliance. They let the youth probation worker know about non-compliance.

### Change

The youth probation worker and the child can request from the Court to amend or stop EM, or order detention.

### Supervision

The youth probation worker agrees about a weekly plan of activities and curfews with the child. If they do not keep to the agreed schedule, this will be discussed on the supervision meeting.

### Youth probation

Youth probation workers communicate with the Probation Service. If the child does not comply with agreed rules, they may refer the case to the court.



### Family

Parents and caregivers must be in touch with the youth probation worker throughout the measure. They are asked to remind the child to keep to the weekly schedule. Children and their families may seek support from the youth probation 24 hours a day.
